PRE-OPENING TEAM UPDATE

October 14, 2020

The last few months offered us multiple opportunities to gather outside safely in person for services and patio visits. As the weather begins to turn, planning for reopening continues as the task team explores ways to gather for the remainder of the year. At this time, we will be holding small group, in person worship services in the Parish Hall on Saturday evenings at 5 pm. Preregistration via Eventbrite and masks are required.

Our plan for reopening into Phase 2, which would allow us to resume services in the Sanctuary at a limited capacity, was approved by the Diocese although no date can be set to reenter at this time. We continue to monitor the health characteristics, including the test positivity rates in Polk and Dallas counties, which will dictate when we can regather in the Sanctuary. The current guideline is that we remain in Phase 1.

To ensure we gather as safely as possible as soon as we are able, we continue to actively prepare for Phase 2. We are putting plans into place for cleaning, bathroom, and building usage. When we move into regathering in the Sanctuary, attendance will be limited to approximately 40-50 people to ensure social distancing. Those attending will need to preregister and wear masks.


