What is one thing in this story that stands out to you?

What crossroads was Moses facing in this passage? I wonder what Moses said to Jethro when he got home that night?

What is the task God wants Moses to do? What are Moses' qualifications for the job? What qualifications is he lacking? What is God's solution?

How would this story be told if you were there instead of Moses? What qualifications do you have for the task? What qualifications are you lacking? What would God say to you?

New Testament Matthew 25:14-30

This parable congratulates wise money investing. How would you describe yourself at managing your money? What would you say you are good at managing?

Zero in on the sentence at the end of the passage. "If you do nothing you will have nothing." How might you explain that to someone else?

Now go back to the beginning of the passage where it says, "A man was heading out of town, and he wanted his servants to take care of his money while he was gone." If we assume that "a man" is God and you and I are the servants, I wonder why God trusts you and I to take care of his things.

Take some time to wonder – What do I have (objects) (abilities) that God would like me to stop keeping buried and safe?
