


CHILDREN'S FORMATION

RE-OPENING REMINDERS & SEARCH UPDATES

RE-OPENING WORSHIP SERVICES & GATHERINGS

June 9, 2021

A few new changes are happening at St. Timothy's! We have recently submitted our Phase 3 plan to the Diocese (https://www.iowaepiscopal.org/abounding-in-hope) which will allow us to increase our attendees on Sunday mornings. Masks will continue to be required for indoor services as per the Diocesan guidelines as well as to keep our non-vaccinated members safe.

Communion will now be offered during service directly to parishioners. The usher will release rows to keep spacing and hand sanitizer will be available in the aisle.

Beginning Sunday June 13th, please join us outdoors by the parking lot after service for a BYO coffee and social hour! Light snacks and water, individually packaged, will be available. Walk-up communion will be offered during this time in lieu of drive-up communion; please park in the main parking lot.

We also begin Saturday evening patio services on June 12th at 5 pm and beginning June 19th, there will also be a social hour after the Saturday services! Similar to last summer, please bring your own lawn chairs and drinks. Clergy will distribute communion. Masks are optional. Physical distancing encouraged.

Registration will be maintained through July for both our Saturday and Sunday services. No registration required for the outdoor social hour on Sundays which will begin at approximately 11:00 am. Live streaming will continue Sunday mornings. Please join us online and use the chat feature to say hello!

With Phase 3, groups can also now meet in the parish hall at 50% capacity which would allow up to 45 members in the parish hall. Outdoors is still highly encouraged when feasible. Please coordinate any gatherings with the office.

SEARCH TEAM UPDATE

The Search Committee and vestry met with Bishop Scarfe last Sunday to discuss St. Tim's search and implications for the timeline we have previously developed as the result of some impending changes at the diocesan office.

Since the diocese helps St. Tim's by advertising our position and screening candidates, we appreciate notice of these changes and the opportunity to modify our timeline to ensure St. Tim's gives candidates full and fair consideration.

The first change at the diocesan level is the resignation of our diocesan transitions officer, Steve Godfrey, for a position with the diocese of North Dakota. Shortly after that, convention delegates will meet to select a new bishop of Iowa. Bishop Scarfe and the new bishop will have a host of transition issues to address, among them, St. Timothy's search.

We anticipate that our position will be advertised during September and October. After the diocesan office screens applications for potential "red flags", the Search Committee will screen applicants and conduct interviews during November and December.

In January and February, Search Committee members will visit candidates in their home parishes to hear them preach and to meet with them personally. In March, the Search Committee will present final candidates to the vestry. The vestry will then interview candidates and issue a call to become our next rector in April or May.



Need Vegetable Plants for Your Garden? Free tomato, eggplant, and a few other varieties of vegetable plants are available for pick-up from the Faith & Grace Garden Greenhouse. Text Mark Marshall 515-988-5381 with questions or to arrange a convenient pickup time.

Spring planting is now over...here's what is growing in the garden:

So far, we have planted cabbages (1,100), onions (5,000), tomatoes (650), peppers (700), sweet potatoes (1,200) plus lettuce, blueberries, cucumbers, spinach, beets, garlic, asparagus, zucchini, and radishes in the garden.

Next, we will be planting melons and squash. Summer watering is in full swing...can you help? Weather forecasts calling for a hot and dry summer this year seem to be coming true.. We are busily installing a drip irrigation system in the garden, starting with the tomato patch. But we need watering help! Even an hour a week will make a big difference.
